Annual Yearly Progress

Sufficient Progress in meeting AYP is defined by both State Law and the No Child Left Behind Act

There are THREE components measured for academic growth, known as Adequate Yearly Progress - AYP

Reading

Math

Attendance Rate

Both test scores and the participation rates are counted. A certain percentage of students, in each of ten possible student subgroups, must reach grade-level proficiency in both reading and mathematics for the school to meet AYP.



If any group does not meet AYP in reading or mathematics, then the entire school will not meet AYP.
